- Job and Family Services: A Resolution authorizing the acceptance of 6 Child Placement contracts that were solicited and received in response to the Child Placement Request for Proposal (RFP) that was dated October 21, 2024.
 These contracts will run from April 1, 2025, through March 31, 2027.
 These contracts will provide child placement and related services for children in the custody of Stark County Job and Family Services:
 - 1Trust Group Home, LLC
 - A Place of Hope, LLC
 - Acts 1:8 Housing
 - Brighter Future For Youth, LLC
 - Skyfall Residential Homes, LLC
 - Turning Point Residential Service, LLC

- Job and Family Services: A Resolution approving an agreement with Adoption STAR, Inc. for child placement and adoption services.
This agreement will provide services to assist in the placement and adoption of a child in the permanent custody of Stark County Job and Family Services. The agreement will be effective from the date the Board of Stark County Commissioners approves the agreement and continue through April 30, 2026. The amount of the agreement shall not exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00).

The Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District is requesting the Board approve the preparation of plans specs and opinion of probable costs for the replacement of Tulane (No. 80), Plum (No. 81) and Winchester (No. 87) sanitary lift stations, to be known as Project 640.

The Stark County Sanitary Engineer is requesting the Board of Commissioners to approve Change Order No. 1, with Chivers Construction Inc., for additional labor & materials necessary to complete the P-627 Lift Station Replacement Project – LS 42 Bowdale & LS 57 Parkview Harbor. The total non-performance items for this change order are \$0 and the total additions for this change order are \$53,061.82. The original contract amount for this project was \$2,539,448.00 and the adjusted contract amount, factoring any previous change orders and the additions and non-performance items above, is \$2,592,509.82.

- A Resolution approving the 2025 Stark County Jail Housing Contracts between the Board of Commissioners, the Stark County Sheriff, the City of Alliance, the City of Canton, and the City of Massillon.
The Stark County Sheriff is requesting the Board to approve and authorize itself to sign a Stark County Jail Housing contact with the City of Alliance, the City of Canton and the City of Massillon. The agreements will be effective, retroactively, from March 1, 2025 through February 28, 2026. The rate will be \$131.65 per day per prisoner, together with the fees required by Section 311.17 (B) (3) (a) of the ORC or subsequent revisions thereof.
- A Resolution approving the 2025 Memorial Day Observance Allowance.
- Acknowledgement of the filing of “The Trump Ave. SE – Orchardview Dr. SE - 2024 Annexation” on April 22, 2025 by the City of Canton and noting that it is an Expedited Type 2 Annexation.
On April 22, 2025, the “The Trump Ave. SE – Orchardview Dr. SE - 2024 Annexation” petition to annex 84.568-acres from Canton Township to the City of Canton was filed with the Board. This is an Expedited Type 2 annexation and does not require a public hearing. Within 5 days after the petition was filed, the agent will notify the municipality, township, and others of the petition’s filing. Within 25 days of the filing the municipality and township file their consent or objection to the annexation with the Board. If neither party responds, it is presumed to be their consent. If no objection is filed, the Board will grant the annexation at its next regular meeting. If an objection is filed, the Board will review the petition on a limited basis, not less than 30 or more than 45 days from the date of filing and grant or deny the petition.
