- A Resolution establishing a New Fund for the Stark County Engineer's Perry Drive Traffic Signal Project.
The Stark County Engineer's office has requested the following new fund to be established for the purpose of tracking the receipt and expenditures of said funds:

- A Resolution approving the installation of "No Engine Brake" signs on Sherman Church Ave. (CR-246) between Fohl St. and Faircrest St. located in Canton Township.

The County Engineer received a petition request from Canton Township residents living along Sherman Church Ave. (CR-246) to install "No Engine Brake" signs between Fohl St. and Faircrest St. located in Canton Township. This request from the residents is because of the loud noise from trucks using their engine brake to slow down at all times of the day and night in this vicinity of Sherman Church Ave. (CR-246). The zone will be 1.71 miles in length in the North bound direction of the east side of the roadway north of Commerce St. For the signs to be legal and enforceable, the County Engineer requests that the Board approve a resolution restricting the use of engine brakes pursuant to Section 4513.221(E)(4) of the Ohio Revised Code.

Commissioners (Jennifer Odey)

- A Resolution appointing a Stark County Apiary Inspector for the 2026 season. The Board of Commissioners is requested to appoint Doug Gerber of Canton, OH as a Stark County Apiary Inspector. Doug has been keeping bees since 1970 and was a Stark County Apiary from 2020 season through the 2022 season. A \$10,000 appropriation is recommended for the 2026 season and will be split between inspectors. Mr. Gerber will generally inspect the east half of Stark County. The Board is requested to approve the appointment of Mr. Gerber and authorize itself to sign the appointment form.

- A Resolution approving a three-year agreement with Maximus Consulting Services, Inc. to prepare central services cost allocation plans for use in 2027, 2028 and 2029.

The Board is requested to approve and authorize itself to sign a Professional Consulting Services Agreement with Maximus Consulting Services, Inc. to prepare central services cost allocation plans for use in 2027, 2028 and 2029. The total cost of the agreement is not to exceed \$17,000.00 per year for a total amount not to exceed \$51,000.00.

- A Resolution approving a Second 60-Day Agreement Extension between Yates Technology and the Board of Commissioners of Stark County. Yates Technology and the Board of Commissioners are currently negotiating a new agreement to host and maintain the Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS). On November 8, 2023, the Board approved an Agreement until November 30, 2025. The negotiations continue with a second request to extend the previous agreement until April 1, 2026. The Board is requested to approve and authorize itself to sign the Second 60-Day Extension Agreement.
