The contract term will be from April 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027, with multiple options for Per Diem room and board rates.

The Mt. Pleasant Detention Basin Expansion Project is fully completed, inspected, and approved. It is the recommendation of the Stark County Subdivision Engineer that this Board adopt a Resolution of Acceptance, and authorize the retainage be released and paid to the contractor, United Earthworks, LLC in the amount of \$63,434.40.

- A Resolution Authorizing the submittal of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – Nationwide Permit Certification on the Mt. Pleasant Basin Improvement Project.

On March 1, 2023, a professional services agreement was approved with ms consultants, Inc. to develop construction plans for the Mt. Pleasant Detention Basin Improvements Project. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – Nationwide Permit Pre-Construction Notification (PCN) was submitted on March 20, 2024, for the project. MS Consultants Inc prepared the PCN for the Mt. Pleasant Basin Improvement, and now requests the Board of Stark County Commissioner, owner of the Mt. Pleasant Basin Improvement, to authorize the President of the Board to validate and sign the Certification that said project is completed in accordance with the terms and conditions of the permit.

- A Resolution approving a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Ohio Secretary of State, the Stark County Board of Elections, and the Stark County Commissioners regarding the purchase of Electronic Pollbooks.

The Stark County Commissioners are requested to approve and authorize the County Administrator to sign an MOU between SOS, the Board of Commissioners, and the Board of Elections to document the roles and responsibilities of each party in complying with the requirements set forth in Section 395.30 of House Bill 96, the State Operating Budget for FY 26. Section 395.30 concerns the purchase of the selected electronic pollbooks and any other necessary equipment and the County's responsibility for 15% of the purchase costs of those pollbooks as determined by DAS and Secretary of State.

- A Resolution approving the participation in the submission of the FY25 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Grant application by the City of Canton and authorizing the President of the Board to sign the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Canton and the Board of Commissioners for participation in the FY25 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Grant.

The Stark County Sheriff is requesting the Board of Commissioners to approve the participation in the submission of the FY25 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Grant Application by the City of Canton, and authorizing the Board of Commissioners to sign the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Canton and the Board of Commissioners for participation in the disbursement of JAG funds with each to receive \$49,884.50 from the FY25 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG Grant.

- A Resolution approving the 2026 Memorial Day Observance Allowance.
Section 307.66 of the Ohio Revised Code, authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to appropriate and advance, upon application made, to any camp of the United Spanish War Veterans, to each garrison or naval branch of the Army and Navy Union, U.S.A., and to each chartered camp, post, or garrison, or naval branch of any organization of veterans recognized and chartered by the Congress, a sum of money not to exceed \$500. Also, where such appropriation by the Board of County Commissioners is made to a civic organization, it shall be in an amount not to exceed \$100.00. The Board is requested to approve the 2026 Memorial Day Observance Allowances in the amount of \$6,400.00.

This grant will provide 75% of the approximate requested amount of \$59,300, leaving a 25% local match amount of approximately \$14,825, to update multiple items within the department.
