**ESTABLISHING VIEWING AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED
DITCH IMPROVEMENT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revised Code § 6131.07, this Board has received notice of the filing of a petition for a ditch improvement under Revised Code Chapter 6131, styled as the Noble's Pond and Rudy Friedman Ditch Improvement; and

WHEREAS, Revised Code § 6131.07 requires this Board to fix a date and hour for the view of the proposed improvement together with a subsequent date and hour upon which to hold its first hearing on the improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the date and time fixed for the view the proposed ditch improvement shall be:

(western most corner of the parking lot)

If the view is not completed on the stated date, the board shall adjourn the view from day to day, or a longer period, until the view is completed.
