RELAXATION OF PANDEMIC RESTRICTIONS

The General Division Judges of the Stark County Court of Common Pleas make the following Findings of Fact:

1. The Center for Disease Control has classified Stark County as a “low” risk county based on hospital bed usage, hospital admissions, and the total number of new COVID cases.
2. Weekly epidemiological reports on COVID-19 from the local Public Health Departments have documented a consistent and significant decline in Stark County cases since January 6, 2022.

Based upon these Findings of Fact, the General Division of the Court of Common Pleas has relaxed several pandemic restrictions and procedures, specifically:

- The Judges have lifted the mandatory mask requirement in the courthouse and the Frank T. Bow Building. Individuals may continue to wear masks. And masks are still available to staff and visitors to the buildings.
- Temperatures will no longer be scanned at the building entrances.
- Facility access restrictions have been relaxed.

Weekly Public Health Department data will continue to be monitored. If there is another COVID surge, the mask requirement and other restrictions may be revisited.
