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Upcoming Open House for State Street and Cleveland Avenue Intersection Improvement Project *STA State St/Cleveland Ave (PID 117499)*

(July 15, 2025) - The Stark County Engineer's Office, in cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), is planning to improve the intersection of State Street (CR 31) and Cleveland Avenue (CR 66) in Lake Township, Stark County. Our goal is to reduce congestion and enhance safety while preserving the character of Greentown Square. A feasibility study completed in May of 2025 looked at 21 different scenarios and determined that a single lane roundabout is the best solution. The project will also include new sidewalks, lighting, landscaping, and crosswalks.

We anticipate that project construction will begin in 2028. To build the project, it will be necessary to acquire permanent and/or temporary right of way from some property owners. If your property is affected, you will be contacted directly to explain the process and your rights.

The Stark County Engineer's Office and ODOT invite you to attend and participate in an upcoming public open house on August 14, 2025, from 5:00 - 7:00pm at the Greentown Fire Station, 10100 Cleveland Ave NW. You are welcome to stop by at your convenience to view project exhibits, talk with Stark County Engineer's staff and our consultants, and submit comments. No formal presentation will be given.
