

Stark County Parenting Time Order Program

Being a responsible father is not just about financially supporting your child, it is also about being an involved, active parent who plays a daily part in your child's life.

Non-Custodial Parents who have been denied parenting time can now apply to receive services to establish or enforce parenting time.

If you have been denied parenting time with your child, and cannot afford legal assistance to establish a parenting time order in court, or to enforce compliance with an existing order, the Parenting Time Order Program may be able to help you.

You may qualify to receive free legal assistance to establish or enforce an order for parenting time if:

- you are at or below the 250% poverty level and
- there is not a risk of domestic violence.
