For something lighter, check out our Little Free Library. In partnership with Stark Library, this rotating collection offers a wide range of genres—perfect for a break from legal research. Once you've picked your next read, stay awhile and enjoy our air-conditioned space and cozy seating.

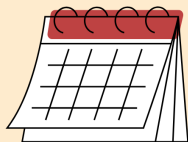

Create a Reading Journal for Summer Reading

Reading journals are great tools to help with retention, media literacy, and foster critical and free-thinking. These journals help improve your reading experience by keeping track of what you read and create a space where you can reflect on what you read.

Reading journals do not need to follow any particular format, but some things to include are:

- Blank pages in the beginning for an index
- Reading goals
- Title, author, format
- Number of pages
- Dates read



Ultimately, a reading journal is to help enhance your engagement with your books. This time of reflection sets the intention of slowing down and enables you to process the content thoroughly and accurately.

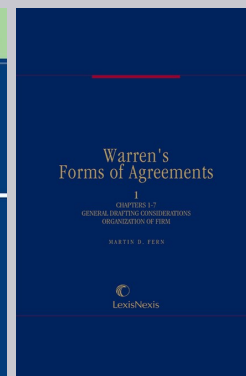
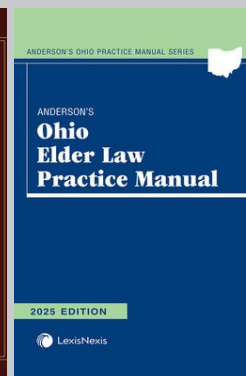
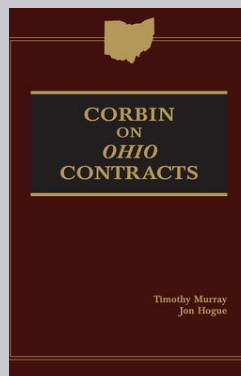
