**ENTRY DIRECTING DEPOSIT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY IN LIEU OF BOND
AND ORDER TO INVEST FUNDS**

This matter came on to be heard this day on the application of _____, the duly appointed and acting guardian of the within estate for an order directing deposit with _____, the ward's assets described in the application, to fix the amount of bond, and to grant authority to invest.

The Court finds the application well taken and it is therefore granted.

The Court finds that the above financial institution is qualified to serve as a depository under the provisions of R.C. 21 09.13.

It is therefore **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the Guardian deposit with said depository the assets described in the application; that the assets, including income, not be withdrawn except upon special order of this Court; that at the time of making the deposit said depository shall execute and deliver to such Guardian a Verification acknowledging that it holds the assets and income subject to this order and the further orders of this Court; and that the Guardian shall file such Verification with this Court;

It is further **ORDERED** that the Guardian is granted authority to instruct the depository to invest and reinvest the personal property deposited hereunder in accordance with the investment powers and limitations set forth in R.C. 2109.37 and 2109.371 without obtaining additional orders of the Court and the depository is hereby granted authority to carry out such investment instructions in reliance upon the specific representation of the Guardian that such investment complies, at the time such investment is made, with the percentage limitations of R.C. 2109.37 and 2109.371; and that the amount of the Guardian's bond is hereby set at \$ _____
