Facility FOGBMP Setup

FOGBMP – Fats, Oils, Greases - Best Management Practices

Dear FSE Owner/Manager,

In February of 2022, Stark County Metropolitan Sewer District implemented a new online program, FOGBMP, for our Food Service Establishments (FSEs), which our office will require them to use to manage Fats, Oils, and Grease (FOG) from their businesses. By accessing and regularly monitoring your facility's account on **fogbmp.com**, you receive helpful information, education, and materials to operate in compliance with our rules and regulations. The program provides a way for you, or your pumping company, to record the required pumping manifests for grease interceptors and includes maintenance logs for you to use, along with best management practices, access to review on-site FOG inspections, employee training, and downloadable kitchen signage for handling grease. As an FSE customer of Stark County, you and your pumping contractor must upload Grease Interceptor cleaning records and utilize the fogbmp.com website. There is no cost to access or use the website.

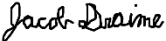
Please remember that all Stark County Sewer FSEs are **required** to use this program for FOG reporting purposes. To use the program, please complete the attached primary contact form with the user's name, job title, and the email address you wish to use to access your facility's account. **Mail the completed form back to me. You can also scan and email this form to jtdraime@starkcountyohio.gov. A welcome email will be sent to you to perform the setup.**

It is important for leadership at your FSE, such as Area Managers or District Managers, to have a user account for your facility on the fogbmp.com website. If your business structure requires only corporate-level or employees, such as area managers, to have access to fogbmp.com for your FSE, proper FOG-related information and materials should still be given to staff at the facility level, so that each facility can remain compliant.

It is in our best interest to ensure grease interceptors are pumped at a **frequency of every 90 days**, and that our FOG best management practices are followed. You can review our rules and regulations on our website.
