Dear Taxpayer:

On behalf of the Stark County Treasurer's Office, we need to inform you that First Merit Bank will no longer accept property tax payments at their bank branches.

Since this eliminates one method of paying your property taxes to the Stark County Treasurer, we wanted to review the methods that are available for you to pay your property taxes:

1. Mail your check by the due date to the Stark County Treasurer in the envelope provided with your property tax bill. Please write your Parcel Number(s) on your check and include the bill stub(s).
2. Pay your property taxes at our office located at 110 Central Plaza South, Suite 250, Canton, OH 44702.
3. Deposit your tax bill stub(s) and check(s) in an envelope into our drop box located in the lobby of the Stark County Office Building located at 110 Central Plaza South. The lobby is open Monday thru Friday 7:30AM to 5:00 PM. The Stark County Office Building is closed on National Holidays.
4. Pay your property taxes via online bill pay with your bank. Make your check payable to The Stark County Treasurer and have it mailed to 110 Central Plaza South, Suite 250, Canton, OH 44702. Please enter your Parcel Number as your account number, and each Parcel Number must be paid as a separate transaction to ensure proper credit.
5. Pay your property taxes via credit card by following the instructions on the back of your tax bill. Please note each Parcel Number must be paid as a separate transaction to ensure proper credit. A convenience fee will be charged by the company administering the program.
6. Sign up for our Semiannual Automatic Withdrawal Payment of your Property Taxes. Property tax bills are due in February and July, and this plan allows the Treasurer to withdraw your property tax payment from your checking or savings account.
7. Sign up for our Monthly Prepayment of Property Taxes by Automatic Withdrawal. Our Monthly Prepayment program is for taxpayers who wish to pay their property taxes in installments rather than a large lump sum twice a year. Your Half Year Property Taxes are divided into five installments, and we will automatically withdraw the monthly prepayment amount directly from your checking or savings account.

An Automatic Withdrawal agreement form is printed on the reverse side of this letter. If you are interested please complete it and return it to the address printed at the bottom of the form. Please do **not** return the agreement in the envelope provided for your property tax payment. Payment of Property Taxes by Automatic Withdrawal

The Stark County Treasurer accepts payments by Automatic Withdrawal from a checking or savings account. Please initial the Automatic Withdrawal method you prefer:

Semiannual Installments: Automatic Withdrawals from a checking or savings account will occur twice a year. A Property Tax Bill will be mailed in January to show the withdrawal amount for the First Half which will occur the second Wednesday in February and in June to show the withdrawal amount for the Second Half which will occur the second Wednesday in July.

Monthly Installments: Automatic Withdrawals from a checking or savings account will occur on the 15th of the month. (If the 15th is on a holiday or weekend, the withdrawal will occur on the next business day.) A letter will be mailed in early September stating monthly withdrawal amounts from September through December for the First Half Taxes. A second letter will be mailed in January with the First Half Property Tax Bills stating the withdrawal amounts from February through May for the Second Half Taxes. Property Tax Bills will be mailed; 1) in January to show the final withdrawal amount for the First Half which will occur the second Wednesday in February and 2) in June to show the final withdrawal amount for the Second Half which will occur the second Wednesday in July.

If a withdrawal is declined by a financial institution for any reason, this agreement is voided and payment for Property Taxes must be made in the normal manner.
