

RULE 20 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CIVIL PROTECTION ORDERS

20.01 The Domestic Relations Clerk of Court for Stark County shall distribute upon request forms and instruction packets for use in civil protection order proceedings under 3113.31 of the Ohio Revised Code. The packet includes forms and instructions promulgated by the Court which are substantially similar to **Forms 1-6 as provided in the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 65.2.**

20.02 An action for a Civil Protection Order pursuant to Section 3113.31 of the Revised Code shall be commenced by filing a petition form that is substantially similar to **Form 4 as provided in the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 65.2.**

20.03 In every case in which the Court issues or approves an ex parte civil protection order, a full hearing civil protection order, or a consent agreement pursuant to section 3113.31 of the Revised Code, the Court shall be provided, as applicable, with a proposed order which is substantially similar to **Forms 7-8.**

20.04 Every ex parte civil protection order, full hearing civil protection order and consent agreement presented to the Court for approval must include a cover sheet that is substantially similar to **Form 3.**

Every ex parte civil protection order, full hearing civil protection order, consent agreement, order for continuance or order to modify a civil protection order must include **Form 27** which is the Protection Order Notice to NCIC set forth by **Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure 65.2.** Petitioners shall be required to supply identifying information on **Form 27** including names, addresses, Social Security numbers, dates of birth, physical description, vehicle information and a list of all protected persons. The Clerk of Courts shall cause **Form 27** to be sent to the Stark County Sheriff's Office which will enter this information into the NCIC.
